6) The Town voted to allow Troy Volunteer Fire Dept. and Masonic Union Lodge #16, exempt from Education Property Tax Liability for a period of five years. (Jim Starr)

7) The Town of Troy appropriated \$195,870 for the General Fund Budget for 2015, adjusted with the approval of the numerous appropriations ensuing in the Warning. (Jim Starr)

8) The Town of Troy appropriated \$452,685 for the Road Budget for 2015. (Roland Mayhew)

9) The Town of Troy appropriated \$2,907,000 to Troy School District for the year beginning July 1, 2015. (Cliff Forster)

10) The Town of Troy appropriated \$11,644.22 to the Orleans County Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services. (Roland Mayhew)

11) The Town of Troy appropriated to Northeast Kingdom Human Services, Inc. \$1745.00 to assist in maintaining services in mental health, mental retardation, family counseling and services to children and the elderly, including 24-hour emergency services. (Jim Starr)

12) The Town of Troy appropriated \$300.00 to Orleans County Court Diversion, a community service program to assist in maintaining existing services to the increase of juvenile and adult offenders, and the victims of their crimes. (Sue Brassett)
