BOARD OF SELECTPERSONS MINUTES

The Board of Selectpersons held their monthly meeting on Tuesday, May 16, 2023, at

6:30 p.m. at the Troy Municipal Office.

- 1. The meeting opened at 6:30 pm.
- 2. (a) Steve reported the interrogator is now working.
 - (b) The engineer from Aldrich and Elliott did a site visit to the pump station and also the South Pleasant Street water line. He indicated the environmental impact study should be done in the next few months and after we would be looking into the available funding from USDA and the SRF Fund. Steve asked that they break down the project in two phases. One being just So. Pleasant Street and the other Kennison Road.
- 3. Jenn Harlow came to the meeting to discuss any needs the town had as far as patrolling.
- 4. (a) Mike reported that all the roads are in good condition.
 - (b) All bridges have been cleaned.

(c.) The planks on our temporary bridge on Veilleux road have been removed by the snow mobile club.

(d) They will start hauling winter sand from Starr's Pit on the 22nd or 23rd.
(e) Terri and Mike discussed with the board that the Village's backhoe needs repairs. Mike explained that the town uses the backhoe throughout the year for various things and asked about the town paying for part of the cost of repairs. Terri will get an estimated cost for repairs and let the board know at the next meeting.

- 5. Gaston discussed the email we received regarding a charging infrastructure grant. Terri is going to email Craig Oshkello, who sent the email, and request a virtual meeting to discuss the program.
- 6. Terri reported Robert Judd, from Troy school, has been working on the village land behind the ball diamond so the students can ride bikes there. They need a culvert in an area and asked if the \$750.00 youth recreation appropriation

monies could be used to purchase a culvert. A motion was made by Anne to pay up to \$750 for the culvert.

- 7. Minutes from the April 18, 2023, meeting was approved by a motion made by Gaston.
- 8. All Orders were approved.
- 9. One liquor license for outdoor consumption for the American Legion was approved by a motion made by Gaston.
